Tariff incentives policy

ONDA's tariff policy, while adhering to the principle of nondiscrimination towards airline companies, has aimed since 2005 at supporting:

- ➤ Attractiveness of Morocco destination
- The creation of new international air routes (regular and charter flights)
- The increase of flight frequencies to Morocco
 - The development of Casablanca
 Mohammed V Airport as a regional hub
 - The encouragement of domestic routes development

You will find in this document all the tariff incentives:

- ➤ Charter traffic
- > Regular traffic
- → Large accounts and volumetric incentive policy
- Night traffic
- Hub traffic at Casablanca Mohammed v airport

Only measures related to traffic hub, to the policy of large accounts and to the volumetric incentive for passenger and security are cumulative; all other incentives contained in this document are not cumulative.

■ Incentives fees

Moroccan Airports Authority implemented pricing policy incentives to attract airlines.

These rates were studied in order to:

- Promote the creation of new international air links (regular and charter),
- ➤ Increase frequency of scheduled flight to the destination Morocco,
- ➤ Encourage the development of domestic routes

Charter traffic

■ Point-to-point routes

| ~ | -50% | on passenger charges |

Applicability conditions:

- The line should not be served by any regular routes during the concerned season.
- ➤ The carrying out of at least 19 services during winter season and 28 during summer season. A credit note will then be issued to companies meeting this condition.
- All Moroccan airports are concerned except Casablanca Mohammed V and Rabat Salé.

Increase in the number of passengers



-50% on passenger charges

- Transport of at least 1500 additional passengers during winter season and 2300 during summer season. A credit note will then be issued to companies meeting this condition.
- ➤ This measure applies to increases of carried passengers compared to the previous year.
- All Moroccan airports are concerned except Casablanca Mohammed V and Rabat Salé.





Regular traffic

■ Development of the proximity traffic

To develop the traffic originating from destinations nearby Morocco (Canary Islands, south of France, south of Spain and Portugal, etc.). This incentive is applicable to the flights operated by aircrafts with tonnage lower than 50 tons on all point-to-point routes to Morocco.

-50% on landing charges for the aircrafts of less than 50 tons.

- → All Moroccan airports are concerned except Rabat Salé.
- → Regular commercial flights
- Minimal frequency: 2 frequencies per week

■ Creation of routes and frequencies connecting Mohammed V airport to various countries in Africa and Middle-East:

Additional frequencies

: -50% Passenger charges

New routes

: -50% Passenger charges

-50% Approach charges

-50% Landing charges

Applicability conditions:

- > Exploitation of the frequency/route for at least two consecutive seasons. Airline companies having operated a minimum of 19 frequencies during winter season and 28 during summer season will be granted a credit note.
- This is applicable on increasing the number of frequencies carried over the previous similar season

■ Creation of routes and frequencies applicable to all Moroccan airports including Marrakech Menara and Agadir Al Massira on point-to-point routes by distinguishing additional frequencies and new routes:

Additional frequencies

: -50% Passenaer charaes

New routes

: -50% Passenger charges -50% Approach charges -50% Landing charges

- > Exploitation of the frequency/route for at least two consecutive seasons. Airline companies having operated a minimum of 19 frequencies during winter season and 28 during summer season will be granted a credit note.
- ➤ All Moroccan airports are concerned except Casablanca Mohammed V and Rabat Salé.
- > This is applicable on increasing the number of frequencies carried over the previous similar
